A health talk regarding the do's and don'ts was given by Ms. Janki Mehta. She also informed the children about Ear care and early identification of deafness.

They were specially informed about dirty water infection in ear. As most of villagers use to take bath in river the river water inserted in ear and cause infection. So, they should protect their ear such dirty water infection from river and ponds water. If any reason their ear got infected or pain, they should not use hot oil and other house

remedies to protect their ear. In this case only go to dispensary or ENT doctor for treatment.

After giving information children were asked in form of quiz some questions regarding ear care and do's and don'ts. It was found that children very excited to answer the questions and full of energy to know and tell that they had learnt about in the school.

Mr. Ravi Narayan asked to send some awareness material to display in the school and in future some more programme regarding health related and camp could be organized so that the not even student, the village people can get benefit from this type of programme. As he told that today is last day of before summer vacation so he can't mobilize people from village but in future he will be happy to organize it on large scale.

They were told to tell their parent and in neighbourhood about the information given them in the school and Ear Care.
